Public Hearing

The application of Dr. Jerry Cellura for site plan approval for a 220 sq. ft. building addition to an existing dental office located at 17 West Ave, Spencerport, NY 14559. Such property zoned Commercial B-2.

Robert Bringley of Marathon Engineering will be representing Dr. Cellura's application.

Mr. Bringley: Dr. Cellura's family dentistry has been at this location for a number of years. Dr. Cellura is looking at putting on a small addition on the front of the building. Two weeks ago we went in front of the Zoning Board and received 2 variances; one for site coverage and a side setback. The existing building is 2 ½ feet from the property line and the proposed addition will be 2 ½ feet also from the property line.

The addition will be 11ft. wide and 22 ft. long, architecturally what we would like to do is keep the theme in character with the existing building. What we are doing is taking the façade and bringing it out 22 feet. The building will still be all brick.

The entry way will be upgraded to match the original architecture. In addition to that there are some minor interior upgrades, carpeting, drywall etc.

This is not a big project but will add a lot to the Village.
