2. Sign shall be mounted in safe and secure manner in the existing locations of the current signs.
3. Colors as depicted on application and match existing signs in the plaza.
4. Signage shall be unlit.
5. Signage to be kept in good condition as determined by the VOS ARB.
6. After signage is installed the applicant shall submit a photograph of such to the Village Clerk.
