Superintendent West updated the board on the following:

- Busy month with snow removal. We still have well over 300 ton of salt stock piled at the Town of Ogden.
- At Tooty's Restaurant, 42 Nichols Street a new water line had to be installed.

Superintendent West: I would like to commend Paul Robinson who went up their on his own time when they hit the water line. Paul jumped right in and it really helped the process. He did an excellent job.

Mayor Walker: The issue with that was when this occurred the entire plaza was without water.

- Waterline has been installed to the Public Works Building by the Water Authority. We are currently doing the restoration work.
- Installing new sidewalks on Upton Avenue, Bowery Street. This will start in the next two weeks.
- Heavy sewer flows and the plant this past weekend due to all the rain. The plant was off for a couple of days.
- Major vandalism at the Pavilion. Will be discussing this with Ogden Police.

**Superintendent of Electric** – John E. Linder

Superintendent Linder updated the board on the following:

- Breakers at the substation have been all fixed.
- Switch at substation is broken therefore we will be shutting down the substation April 24, 2005 from 2 a.m.-7a.m. to do the first phase of this repair. If there is inclement weather the shutdown will occur on May 1<sup>st</sup> same time frame.
- Thistlewood project should be complete by early spring.
- Working on the street lights.
