- The employee orientation for new health care plan is scheduled for Friday, October 3rd at 7:30 a.m. Bond Financial will be used as the broker of record and will be working with Brian in obtaining rates.
- Successful concert series for 2008 and that Margaret Gioia continues to do a good job coordinating these concerts and at this time Margaret is working on completing 2008 brick orders.
- Follow-up letter will be sent to residents who have not paid their 2008 Village taxes.
- Continues to work with the webmaster to keep the Village website up to date.

Superintendent of Public Works – Thomas M. West

Superintendent West commented on the following items:

- Drainage, gutter and road work has been completed on Prospect Street. Paul Robinson and his crews have done an excellent job coordinating this project. Superintendent West indicated that this project would have cost about \$1,000,000 if it had been done by a contractor. Superintendent West expressed his gratitude to the Board for giving his crews the support to complete these types of projects.
- Paving of Prospect Street will take place on September 15 and 16.
- Work on the Gollel/Canalside Landing project continues. MRB continues to help with this project.
- Sewer, pump station, manhole and tie map issues continue to be addressed; dedication will not take place until these items are corrected.

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- Drainage associated with Timber Ridge has been completed.
- Recycling truck has been ordered and 10 wheel dump truck has been ordered and will be in early October.
- Slip lining of Harwood Road will be complete in a couple of weeks. This work will be done under the Sewer Term Contract with Skanex.
- WWTP decommissioning is nearly complete and finish work/grading is being completed. Buildings and pumps are being removed at this time.
- The Monroe County fiber optic project continues with the assistance of DPW and SME Crews.
- Drainage work on Parkhurst Drive will be taking place when Prospect Street is done.
- All of the life rings have been installed on the Canal bank.
- The Village DPW will be looking into doing County work with the new dump truck.
- Scale system on the new refuse truck continues to not work but the new system should be in within the next month.
