In addition Mayor Penders reported that the Parkview project received preliminary approval with contingencies, the Canal Road LoPresti project is on hold until signed plans are received and the repairs to Mangia – Mangia continue.

Reed Yancey, Rose & Kiernan, Inc. – Upstate New York Municipal Workers Compensation Program (UNYMWCP); Mr. Yancy and Mrs. Kay Wharmby explained the program and the concept of participating municipalities potential of receiving up to 30% of the premium back if they do not have any claims during the coverage year.

Discussion ensued regarding the program and timing of renewal.

The Village Board discussed the village tree that Mr. Jeff Bulmahn, 36 Harwood Road brought to the Board's attention at the last meeting. It was determined that the tree is healthy and that the Village would not consider removing it at this time. A letter will be sent to the residing explaining their decision and that the tree cannot be removed by the resident.
