Trustee Wohlers questioned if the Village sewer meeting regarding Rite Aid should remain open if the project is only going to the Town lot line.

Attorney Stowe responded that a letter should be sent to the applicant indicating that the meeting will be closed unless further progress is made regarding connection to the Village sanitary sewer system.
