Be it resolved, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Spencerport, pursuant to Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law, establishes a reserve to be known as the ERS Retirement Reserve (for Sewer). The source of funds for the ERS Retirement Reserve shall be from such amounts as may be provided therefore by budgetary appropriation or raised by tax therefore, such revenues as are not required by law to be paid into any other fund or account, such other funds as may be legally appropriated, and amounts transferred from other established reserve funds, as allowed by law.
