Village of Spencerport, Monroe County, New York

Local Law no. 4 of the year 2019

A local law to of the Village of Spencerport Code.

Be it enacted by the Village of Spencerport Board of Trustees
as follows:

Section 1: Chapter, Article 1, Section 1. Title.

This local law shall hereinafter be known and cited as a Local Law to Amend Section 259-6(k) of the Village of Spencerport Code

Section 2: Chapter, Article I, Section 1.

§. Legislative Intent, Purpose and Objectives.

It is the intent of this legislation to provide temporary relief from the sign code to the commercial businesses located in the Village of Spencerport while the bridge over the Erie Canal on Union Street is closed.

Section 3: Section 259-6(k) of the Village of Spencerport Code is amended to add subsection (3) as follows:

3. One temporary sign may be erected for each business in all B Zoning Districts pursuant to the following provisions:

- 1. The sign shall be permitted from May 1, 2019 through December 1, 2020.**
- 2. The sign, and all signs for the business, shall comply with all applicable laws pertaining to signs in the Village of Spencerport, including, but not limited to: size, color, shape, situs, total square footage, etc.**
- 3. Prior to issuing a permit for said temporary sign, the Building Inspector shall require each applicant to submit an application containing, at a minimum, the following: an inventory of all signs on the premises, a pictorial representation of the temporary sign and a signed agreement indicating the applicant's understanding that upon expiration of the permit the sign shall be removed.**
- 4. Prior to issuing the temporary permit, the Building Inspector shall require the applicant to demonstrate compliance with all laws pertaining to signs in the Village of**

Spencerport.

- 5. The Building Inspector shall be permitted to extend temporary sign permits issued under this provision for two (2) consecutive three (3) month periods.**
- 6. A fee for this temporary sign permit may be established by the Village Board of Trustees.**

Section 7:

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement shall have been ordered.

Section 8:

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
