Weekly Residential Refuse Collection

In a continuing effort to keep all village residents, new and long time, informed on refuse preparation and collection we have compiled this informational flyer.

The Village of Spencerport collects refuse once a week on a preset schedule. Please place your trash curbside no earlier than 24 hours prior to pick up. If a week contains a holiday, put out your trash on your regular day, if your pick up is on the holiday put out your trash on the next work day. If equipment and personnel are available we will try to get back on schedule. If that's not possible we will get it the next day. But there will be only one pick up per address per week.

Standard Refuse Container: A standard container is a plastic or galvanized metal can between 18 and 32 gallons with a top or a heavy duty plastic bag. There is a 25 lb maximum weight on one of these containers. Each address is allowed **3** of these small standard containers. Any additional cans need a \$2 sticker. The village also offers an alternate standard container which is a 95 gallon rolling refuse cart that can hold up to 150 pounds maximum weight. Each address is allowed one of the rolling refuse carts. The carts and stickers are available for purchase through the Village Office at 27 West Avenue. See the last page for a rolling cart order form.

Cardboard boxes, paper barrels or paper bags are not acceptable standard refuse containers.

Standard Stickers: Standard stickers are available at the Village Office and required to be visibly attached to the following items:

- Any Standard container exceeding 3 for your weekly pick up \$2.00 each
- Tires \$4.00 each
- All Appliances containing Freon \$20.00 each - Remove Doors

Unacceptable Refuse:

The Village can not collect fluorescent bulbs or tubes, gas tanks, propane tanks or any pressurized or flammable items. Infectious waste, hazardous chemicals and oil will not be collected. Contact Monroe County Hazardous Waste Program 760-7600 for information.

The village requests that the blue box be prepared as follows:

Newspapers, magazines, paper, rinsed gable top

cartons and drink boxes are to be placed in a brown paper bag and placed on top of the clean glass, metal and plastic containers and empty aerosol cans.

At this time our County Recycling center does not accept plastic shop-

ping bags. They will end up in the landfill if you put them in your blue box. Supermarkets and stores will recycle bags properly.

Corrugated cardboard is to be cut into manageable sized bundles of approximately 2'x4', tied with twine and placed next to the blue box.

Any recyclable container holding food or beverages should be cleaned and rinsed before placing in the box. This helps to discourage rodents. Remove and discard caps.

Blue boxes that contain material not

acceptable to the recycling center may not be picked up.

Due to the increasing cost for supplying blue bins to our residents we are forced to charge villages residents \$6.50 for a replacement blue box. You may pick up and pay for a replacement bin at the Village Office.

Please note that a new resident to the village will not be charged for their initial blue box.

To Help Prevent Identity Theft: Tear or shred your bills and financial statements before recycling.

Blue Box Acceptable

Aerosol Cans—Totally empty, no pesticides or spray paints

Aluminum Cans-rinsed clean

Tin Cans, including tin plated and bimetal cans - rinsed clean

Brown Kraft paper bags-no food contamination

Corrugated cardboard and box-board (cereal boxes) free of food

Pizza boxes, empty, free of food,

wrappers and spacers

Gable top cartons—milk and juice rinsed clean

Glass-food and beverage containers, including clear glass, brown glass and green glass

Newspapers, supplements, advertising and inserts.

Magazines, catalogs and other glossy publications

Office Paper, white paper, copy paper,

computer print out , colored paper and gift wrap.

Plastic Containers: Soft drink and other PET containers, neck rings OK , discard caps. Natural colored milk jugs and water bottles and colored HDPE containers including personal care products, soap and detergent bottles.

Blue Box Not Acceptable

No trash in the blue box.

No Plastic bags, not even #1 grocery bags

No soiled papers or paper toweling .

No material with food, drink, oil etc.

No Styrofoam: egg cartons, packing peanuts etc.

No Plastic containers #3-#7, i.e.: yogurt or margarine containers

No plastic six pack holders

No Clay flower pots

No diapers

No Coat Hangers

No Ceramics

No Plate glass, leaded glass, auto glass, crystal, china, drinking glasses or Pyrex

No light bulbs or tubes —fluorescent or incandescent

Blue boxes that contain material not acceptable to the recycling center will not be picked up.

2011 BULK Days

January 3, March 7, May 2, July 11, September 12

Each address is allowed one neatly sorted 4'x4'x8' pile placed at the curb. Collected on your trash day.

Sort by Brush, Lumber, Metal, Tires and other Refuse

Village Resident Refuse Only

The intention of the bulk refuse collection is to assist our homeowners when making minor repairs, small remodeling projects, discarding household furniture, mattresses, large appliances, lumber and other bulk household material which is too large or too heavy to place in standard refuse containers.

Lumber should be cut into 4' lengths, all nails removed and stacked neatly.

Large appliances must have doors removed and if required - stickers attached.

Sorting is important because it allows us to pick up specific materials with specific equipment. Brush into a dump truck so it can be later run through a chipping machine. Appliances with Freon need special handling by an outside contractor. Metals go to a metal scrap yard in a different truck. The remaining refuse goes into the garbage

truck and goes to the landfill. So even though different equipment, perhaps on different days, will be used for your pile, you are still only allowed one 4'x4'x8' pile inclusive of all materials. Because of ever increasing costs we can no longer keep visiting every street every day. **Once a street is cleared we will not return.**

If you have more than 4'x4'x8' pile a Village truck or dumpster can be rented for reasonable cost.

Contractors are not eligible for any residential Village Services.

FAQ's

If there is no Bulk pick up scheduled or I have more than fits in a standard refuse container, how should I dispose of construction waste?

If you, the homeowner are making minor repairs, the waste should be placed in a Standard Refuse Container and placed at the curb for your weekly pick up. If debris is more than fits a standard container the Village can rent you a dumpster for \$15.00 per month plus .07cents/pound. Call the Village Office to make arrangements.

What about concrete, dirt (sod), brick or stone?

Because of the weight and labor involved the village will not collect these items curbside; however you may make arrangements to rent a Village truck, at your expense by calling the village office. Availability of trucks can not be guaranteed.

How do I dispose of florescent tubes or compact fluorescent lamps?

Because of the small amount of mercury in these lamps we can not accept them in the trash or recycling box. You can drop off the small compact fluorescent bulbs in a box at the Village Office for proper disposal. The village office is also selling prepaid boxes that will allow you to safely dispose of the larger tubes.

Will the Village be enforcing these guidelines?

Yes, these guidelines represent the rules and regulations of our Village Code, which can be accessed on the village website. Violations can be cited and fines imposed as required.

Leaves



October 1 to December 1



Loose piles between the sidewalk and the curb. No Bags. No branches or large sticks. Large amounts of grass clog the equipment.

Brush



Brush is not picked up with the weekly household refuse .

It is only collected during the bulk collection week unless the DPW Superintendent decides that there has been an unusual weather event that generates a lot of downed branches and debris.

Then, it is the responsibility of the resident to place the brush between the

sidewalk and the curb with large ends facing the curb. Brush should be stacked, not exceeding 6' in length and no more than 3" diameter.

If tree pruning or removal is performed by a contractor or tree surgeon it is the responsibility of the contractor to properly dispose of all debris. The village will not collect it.

When available, residents can make arrangements with the village office to have a village truck placed in the driveway at no charge. Residents will load the truck per directions and in the morning the DPW will bring your tree trimmings and brush to the correct area for chipping.

No large tree trunks, stumps, root balls or lumber.

Grass clippings will not be accepted.
