Holiday Schedule

If a week contains a holiday, put out your trash on your regular day, if equipment and personnel are available we will try to get back on schedule. If that's not possible we will get it the next day.

If your pick up is on the holiday put out your trash on the next work day.

Weekly Refuse Collection

Refuse Container: All residential refuse for pick up shall be put into a rolling refuse container not to weigh more than 150 pounds. The containers must not be filled over their level of capacity. Any additional containers shall have the standard sticker attached and visible from the street. **\$2.00 /additional per bag.**

Unacceptable Weekly Refuse: The Village will not collect electronics, grass clippings, fluorescent bulbs or tubes, gas tanks, propane tanks or any pressurized or flammable items. No collection of waste generated by any commercial contractor. No liquid paint, infectious waste, hazardous chemicals or oil will be collected.

The ecopark is a partnership between Monroe County and Waste Management of NY that provides county residents with a "one-stop drop-off" to dispose of or recycle difficult to manage materials. The ecopark accepts items like electronics, scrap metal, clothing, foam packaging, pharmaceuticals, rechargeable batteries, and more. Properly recycle grocery plastic bags at supermarkets, not in the blue box

Blue Box Recycling

Commingled Recyclables: Any Plastics with the numbers 1-7 within the stamped recycling triangle. (Except #2 Plastic grocery type bags). Metal including: trays & tins, pots & pans, aluminum foil, food & drink cans, aerosol cans (no paints or pesticides), gable top cartons, bottles & jars (green, brown and clear only)

Paper Recyclables: Newspapers & Inserts -Junk Mail-Home Office Paper-Magazines & Catalogs-Envelopes-Phone Directories-Books-Files-School Papers-Gift Wrap-Clean pizza boxes- Paper boxes include cereal, cracker, pasta, shoe gift etc., Please flatten all boxes. Recycle any plastic liners at the store with grocery bags. Pieces should be no larger than 2x4 feet. All shredded paper in clear plastic bags.

Do Not Place in the Blue Box: No Trash, No plastic bags, No soiled papers or paper toweling, No material with food, drink, oil etc. No Styrofoam: egg cartons packing peanuts etc. No clay flower pots, ceramics or coat hangers, No plate glass, leaded glass, auto glass crystal, china, drinking glasses or Pyrex, No diapers, No light bulbs or tubes-fluorescent or incandescent

- For Village Residents Only
- One pile per address no larger than 4'x4'x8'
- One Pick up per address
- Neatly sort pile into metal, wood, brush etc.
- No contractor waste
- Stickers required for tires, appliances with Freon
- **All TV's CRT's or Monitors require sticker purchased from the office**
- No Grass clippings
- No bulk put out before 48 hours prior

A bulk pick up can be purchased and scheduled at other times for a fee of \$50.00 for one 4'x4'x8' pile. Contact the village office. No contractor waste allowed.

The Village of Spencerport will no longer accept drop offs of electronics at our DPW Site. Residents can place their electronics—except monitors and televisions—curbside for pick up during bulk pick up weeks. **All monitors, CRT's and televisions will require the purchase of a \$10.00 sticker in order for them to be picked up curbside - including bulk weeks.**

Brush is collected only during bulk collection week or after an unusual weather event. The DPW does not pick up brush with the weekly household refuse. When available residents can make arrangements with the village office to have a DPW truck placed in the driveway after working hours at no charge. Residents will load the truck per directions and in the morning the DPW will take it away for proper disposal.
